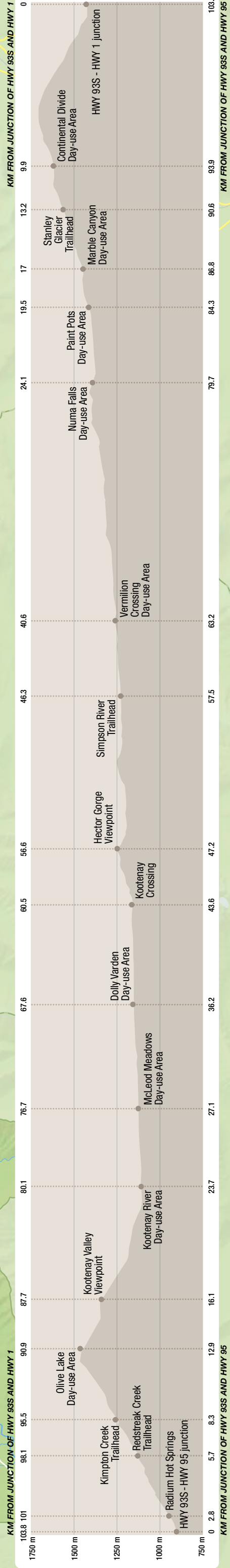


ELEVATION PROFILE AND DISTANCES

12 Paint Pots	2 km return	25 m
13 Marble Canyon to Paint Pots	6.8 km return	40 m
14 Marble Canyon	1.6 km return	20 m
15 Stanley Glacier	8.4 km return	365 m
16 Fireweed Loops	0.5 km and 2 km loops	20 m
