SHALLOW BAY DAY USE AREA AND SKI TRAILS TO CLOSE TEMPORARILY TO ALLOW WORK ON NEARBY POWER LINES

ROCKY HARBOUR, NL, February 13, 2019 –Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro has begun work on a section of the power line corridor within Gros Morne National Park near the Shallow Bay Campground and Day Use Area. This work includes necessary maintenance to the hydro corridor. The work will take approximately three weeks. To ensure public safety while this work takes place, access to the Shallow Bay Day Use area and ski trails will be closed during this time.

The closed area will include 50m either side of the hydro line, including the roads and ski trails from:

- Shallow Bay trailer dumping station to Shallow Bay Day Use Area; and
- The day use area road to the campground service building.

Public safety is a priority for Parks Canada and Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro. Visitors are advised to travel with caution in areas adjacent to where work is occurring, obey all on-site signage and posted speed limits, watch for travel instructions from flag persons and safety personnel, and comply with the temporary area closure notice now in effect.

This regular maintenance work will include removal or trimming of trees to ensure power lines are not impacted by branches or falling trees. Timber cut as a result of the work will be made available to persons eligible to cut timber in Gros Morne National Park. Further details will be provided at a later date to individuals with domestic timber harvest permits.
