ALL RIVERS AND BROOKS IN GROS MORNE NATIONAL PARK CLOSED TO SALMON FISHING

ROCKY HARBOUR, NL, July 23, 2018 – All waters in Gros Morne National Park, including all tributaries and connected ponds, are closed to salmon fishing effective immediately due to low numbers of returning salmon.

In addition the following waters within Gros Morne National Park are closed to all fishing;

- Deer Arm Brook (Eastern Arm Brook);
- Deer Arm Pond (Eastern Arm Pond) within 90 meters of the inflow of the feeder and with 90 meters of the outflow of the pond;
- Ten Mile Pond, including all tributaries;
- Lomond River;
- East Branch Lomond River; and
- Wigwam Pond within 90 meters of the inflow of East Branch and within 90 meters of the outflow of the pond.

Parks Canada is a leader in conservation. In managing the waterways within Gros Morne National Park, Parks Canada's primary concern is to ensure the protection and restoration of healthy, resilient ecosystems and contributing to the recovery of species at risk.
